Course Placement Re-Test Policy

Students who take the ACCUPLACER at Ramapo College and score **within 5 points** of the passing score on any of the multiple-choice sections will be allowed **one re-test opportunity per test section**. There is no re-test option for the essay. The re-test fee is \$10.

Test scores that fall within the following ranges are eligible for the re-test option:

Arithmetic test: **45-49**

Elementary Algebra test: 77-81

College-Level Math (CLM) test: 90-94 (for Calculus) or 60-64 (for Precalculus)

Reading Comprehension test: 71-75

Reclaim My Math

Reclaim My Math is an opportunity for students who score **more than 5 points** from the passing score on any math placement test and place into MATH 013/022/024 to become eligible for re-testing and to improve math course placement before the start of spring classes. The program allows incoming Ramapo students to review and refresh math skills through computer-assisted and classroom instruction, and to connect with classmates via math-related success workshops and problem-solving activities. If placement testing indicates that you need to take CRWT 080/090 or MATH 013/021/022/024, you should consider taking these during the spring (at Ramapo or a community college in your area to transfer in) or enrolling in Reclaim My Math, so you can start 100-level courses in your next semester.
